ANTHEM BULLETIN NOTE: Like thousands of songs in the Shaker music tradition, Gentle Words had fallen out of the oral tradition in the early 20th century, to be rediscovered in 1974 as a manuscript in Shaker history archives. Text and tune were written by Polly Rupe, a prolific female composer from the Shaker community in Pleasant Hill, Kentucky. The text is universal, evoking the ethic of reciprocity, the Golden Rule. Kindness matters. (Kevin Siegried, 1969).
